The Stables is situated in a beautiful rural setting in Wavendon, just to the south east of Milton Keynes and a short drive from the Centre:MK.

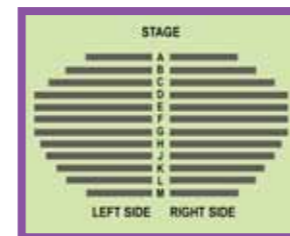
### From M1 Junction 14
